

# How to Setup your BlueHost Account

Follow these steps to set up your BlueHost account:

- 1. Visit the BlueHost Website
  - Go to the BlueHost website: <u>BlueHost Link</u> <u>http://bluehost.sjv.io/threesphere</u>
  - Scroll down and choose the **Basic** or **Choice Plus** plan.
  - In most cases Basic is perfect.

#### 2. Add Your Domain

- On the "Add a Domain" page, select the checkbox "I want to use a domain I already own."
- Enter your domain name (e.g., threesphere.com) and click on "Use This Domain."
- (Don't worry, adding a live domain name, it will not affect your current live website. We will coordinate with GoDaddy or your Domain provider to change the hosting nameservers when necessary.)

#### 3. Skip Plan Add-Ons

- On the "Plan Add-ons" page, do not select any add-ons.
- Click "Continue to Cart."

#### 4. Select Hosting Duration

- On the "Cart" page, under "WordPress Choice Plus Hosting, or Basic Hosting" change the duration from 1 year to 3 years.
- The cost should be very low, which covers hosting and SSL for the next 1 to 3 years. This is a really great deal.



### 5. Uncheck Sitelock Essentials

- On the "Cart" page, uncheck "Sitelock Essentials."
- Click "Continue to Checkout."

#### 6. Complete Checkout

• On the "Checkout" page, fill out your information and complete the checkout process.

## 7. Send Login Credentials

- Once you have completed steps 1 to 6, please email ThreeSphere the login and password for your new BlueHost account.
- I will log in using your credentials one time to add my master account for managing your account.

#### 8. Setup and Collect Assets

- We will set up a test site on your new BlueHost account and start collecting all the assets from your current site.
- This includes grabbing all images and text from the live website and creating the proper pages.
- I will send you the link to this test website so you can keep track of our progress.
